EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST NOW OPEN APPLICATIONS DUE 12TH MARCH 2023

WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

The Collections and Community Resilience Project (CCRP) is a Victorian state-wide initiative that provides regional communities with the opportunity to digitally preserve their collections and receive onsite training in collections care, preventative conservation and risk mitigation in the face of natural disaster events.

WHAT DO I RECEIVE?

The selected organisations will receive up to six days of onsite training across two three-day sessions, held approximately three weeks apart.

In the first session you will receive hands on training in collections care and digitisation, as well a half-day intensive workshop selected from a list of five optional topics.

In the second session, you will receive further digitisation training and additional catalogue photography time with your allocated trainer.

This project is free of charge, with all organisations receiving high quality digital files of their collection items, relevant resources and high-level training to ensure long-term safekeeping of their collections.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for the CCRP you must:

- Be a small to medium sized community museum, historical society, Keeping Place, gallery or community organisation
- Be situated in a regional location or interface local council area
- Have 3+ volunteers or staff available to participate in onsite training
- Be available between mid-April and July for two separate, three-day onsite training sessions, to be held three weeks apart
- Have an available space at your organisation to undertake training and photography work
