Led by all-female artists, BOSS SQUAD aims to empower young people to feel confident and capable in their abilities.

Female led, long-form circus skill and creative development program combining discussion, physicality and performance.

BOSS SQUAD is a full day, circus skills and creative development program combining discussion, physicality and performance, presented by Wildhouse Circus in collaboration with Point & Flex Circus. Presented as a series of workshops, participants are introduced to physical theatre, dance and circus. Students will learn about contemporary circus styles and dramatic techniques.

The workshops create a safe forum to explore topics such as bullying, consent and stereotypes, as the physical nature of circus is uniquely placed for these conversations. Designed to create a safe space to develop awareness of touch, trust and consent while exploring firm and flexible boundaries.

Culminating in a final performance outcome, participants have the opportunity to present work to an audience, allowing them to show the skills they've learnt over the day, as well explore big ideas, difficult topics and start a conversation about something that may have been too challenging otherwise.
